2. REGISTRATION FOR THE SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION: JUNE 2020**

1. SENIOR CERTIFICATE RESULTS FOR JUNE 2019

- Included are the June 2019 Senior Certificate examination results of candidates.
- Candidates may have their scripts re-checked or re-marked for a prescribed fee. The prescribed fees are as follow:
Re-checking of scripts **R27.00**; Re-marking of scripts **R112.00** and viewing of scripts is **R219.00** per subject (only allowed after remarking).
- The closing date for the re-checking/re-marking of Senior Certificate examination scripts is **12 August 2019**. No late applications will be considered.

2. REGISTRATION FOR SENIOR THE CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION: JUNE 2020

Candidates who qualify to write the 2019 Senior Certificate examination may register from the **1 October 2019** and the final closing date is **30 January 2020**.

Manual registration will only take place at the 17 Provincial Education Sub districts. Each candidate must personally register and ensure that he/she get proof that a registration form has been submitted (tear off slip). Candidates must ensure that their registration forms are checked and registered on a spreadsheet indicating the venue allocated for writing the examination. Special Needs Education (SNE) candidates must indicate so.

On-line (internet/web based) registration will also be available for candidates registering in North West Province for the 2020 SC examination. For electronic registration candidates may register on the www.eservices.gov.za portal. No candidate will be registered without a valid SA ID document and a certified copy has to be attached to the registration form.

Only the following learners may enrol for the Senior Certificate:

- (a) Adult learners who are **21 years and older** who have -
 - (i) a General Education and Training Certificate (GETC) for Adult Basic Education and Training (ABET); or
 - (ii) a Grade 9,10 or 11 school report, stating that they have passed the Grade; or
 - (iii) a recognised equivalent qualification obtained at NQF Level 1 which requires two official languages.
- (b) Adult learners who are **21 years and older** with an incomplete Senior Certificate qualification in the year of the Senior Certificate examination;
- (c) National Senior Certificate repeaters and part-time candidates **21 years and older**, who were unsuccessful in obtaining a National Senior Certificate.
- (d) Only in exceptional cases, out of school youth 18-21 years old who could not complete their school education and who want to further their education and training, provided they have obtained the approval of the Head of Education.

3. ADMISSION TO HIGHER INSTITUTIONS


- a) Legislation has been amended to accommodate admission of Senior Certificate candidates to higher education institutions, based on specific rules.
- b) The higher education indicator will appear on the statement of results of candidates who sat for 6 or more subjects in one sitting and qualify for it.

4. COMBINATION OF RESULTS

- a) It is the responsibility of the candidate to apply for the combination of the 2019 Senior Certificate examination results with previous examination sittings, if the candidate has satisfied the qualification requirements.
- b) The applicant must provide the examination numbers and documentary proof of all the previous examination sittings of SC.
- c) Applications can be submitted directly after the release and the different provincial education departments will process the applications.
- d) Candidates need to take note there can be a delay in the processing, because combinations need to be done across different qualifications, different years and across provinces.
- e) Combinations will be preceded by verification of all previous results.

5. PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

1. A Senior Certificate will be issued to an adult candidate who satisfies the following requirements in the examination:
 - a) Passed three subjects at 40%, one of which must be an official language on Home Language level.
 - b) Passed two subjects at 30%, one of which must be an official language on First Additional or Home language level.
 - c) Obtain a sub minimum of 20% in the sixth subject.
