

**SUBJECT: MULTIPLE EXAMINATION OPPORTUNITY (MEO) CANDIDATE SUBJECT  
SELECTION FOR NOVEMBER 2019 and JUNE 2020**

- 1. MULTIPLE EXAMINATION OPPORTUNITY (MEO) CANDIDATE SUBJECT SELECTION FOR NOVEMBER 2019 and JUNE 2020**
  - 1.1. Only schools with Progressed candidates will receive forms populated per candidate.
  - 1.2. The pre-populated forms are attached (see the attached sample) for all the candidates who indicated they are progressed to grade 12 in 2019.
  - 1.3. It should be noted that this is not a registration form for June 2020 but a document that will assist with statistical data as required by DBE and is important for planning purposes. The Candidates will still complete the June registration in January, as it will be released with the results.
  - 1.4. The candidates that receive forms are the only candidates that may be allowed to modularise **(MEO learners) - if they comply with the following conditions:**
    - a) They must be registered as full-time candidates and attend school on a full-time basis and being indicated that they **were progressed** from Gr. 11 in 2018 after verification of ID and progression status that was sent to schools in August 2019.
    - b) The candidates must have failed two to three subjects during the Preparatory Examinations as required by the circular.
    - c) They must do all (at least seven) subjects up to (and write) the Preparatory examination in all subjects in order to compile valid SBA marks. Only MEO learners with valid SBA marks will be allowed to modularise to write subjects in the June 2020 examination to complete the NSC qualification. May modularise a maximum of 3 subjects. Progressed candidates who modularise **must** write 4 subjects, including Life Orientation, during November 2019 examinations

- d) The decision to follow the MEO route may only be taken after completion of the Preparatory examination and the final decision lies with the candidate (and his/her principal).
- 1.5. Progressed learners are afforded the choice and opportunity to write all their subjects in either one examination sitting, or to write their subjects in two or more examination sittings, namely, the end of the year NSC November examinations and the following June mid-year examination.
- 1.6. Progressed candidates must indicate on the form the subjects that will be written during each session.
- 1.7. A particular subject can only be written during ONE of the examination sittings.
- 1.8. No subject changes between sessions will be allowed at a later stage.
- 1.9. Only candidates that wish to write in two (or more) sessions must return the form. Candidates that do not return the registration form will not be afforded the opportunity to write during June the following year.
- 1.10. The principal must submit all completed forms (in one batch) on or before **18 October 2019** to the relevant Sub district/district office. **ONLY FORMS THAT ARE WITH CORPORATE ON THE 21 OCTOBER 2019 WILL BE CAPTURED. NO LATE FORMS WILL BE CONSIDERED**
- 1.11. The District Examination and Assessment Manager (DEAM) must submit all registration forms by **21 October 2019** to the corporate office.

**NB: ALL CANDIDATES THAT MODULARISE CERTAIN SUBJECTS MUST BE BACK IN SCHOOL IN JANUARY 2020 FOR THE SUBJECTS THEY MODULARISE. THEY NEED TO ATTEND CLASSES FOR THESE SUBJECTS AT SCHOOL FROM JANUARY TO THE START OF THE JUNE EXAMINATION. MUST OBEY ALL SCHOOL RULES AND ATTEND IN SCHOOL UNIFORM. THESE CANDIDATES MUST FOLLOW THE PROGRAM AS THE FULL TIME LEARNERS AND COMPLETE ALL TESTS AND TASKS.**

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

- Progressed learners are those candidates that failed Grade 11, but were allowed to progress to grade 12 in terms of DBE Circular E35 of 2015.
- Progressed learners are afforded the choice and opportunity to write all their subjects in either one examination sitting, or to write their subjects in two or more examination sittings, namely, the end of the year NSC November examinations and the following June mid-year examination.
- MEO (multiple examination opportunity) learners must complete the SBA components in all subjects. A decision on which subjects to write must only be made after compilation of the final SBA marks in all subjects.
