#### 1. SUBJECT CHANGES IN GRADES 10, 11 AND 12.

In terms of the Regulations pertaining to the conduct, administration and management of the National Senior Certificate Examination, published as Government Regulation Notice No. R872 in [Government] Regulation Gazette No. 31337 of 29 August 2008 and amended as:

Government Notices No. 1327 and 1328 in Government Gazette, Vol. 522, No.31680 dated 12 December 2008; and

Government Notices No. 1041 and 1042 in Government Gazette, Vol. 533, No.32678 dated 3 November 2009.

Regulation Notice No. 188 in Government Gazette No. 35103 dated 2 March 2012. Regulation Notice No.444 in Government Gazette No. 35429 dated 7 June 2012. Regulation Notice No.371 in Government Gazette No. 37651 dated 16 May 2014. Chapter 3 par 8 (1), (2), (3), (4) (5)

The following must be followed for subject changes in Grade 12

### 1. Procedure for subject changes in grade 12 (learners in Gr 11 during 2021):

Approval for changing a subject for Grade 12 by 15 December of the Gr. 11 must be obtained from the Head of the Examination body. The following must be furnished:

- a) A letter of motivation from the learner's parent or guardian;
- b) A letter from the Principal, either supporting or providing reasons for not supporting the change;
- c) A letter from the subject teacher, outlining the programme to be followed to assist the learner in covering those aspects of the curriculum statements for the previous grade that were covered.





- 1.1 The attached form must be completed and submitted to the office of the Director: Examinations (Attention Ms Kea More) in Mahikeng before 15 December 2021.
- **1.2** All approvals must be finalised and available by the opening of the schools on 12 January 2022.
- **1.3** Proof of the results and the SBA/CASS portfolio for the subject dropped must be available up to six months after the learner completed Grade 12.
- 1.4 A learner taking Physical Sciences must also take Mathematics not Mathematical Literacy.
- 1.5 A letter of approval by the Head of Assessment will be sent to the school for the learner.
- 1.6 No learner may be moved to another subject without approval in writing from the Head of Assessment. Learners changing subjects without approval will not be allowed to write the "new" subject in the final examinations.
- **1.7** A copy of the letter of approval must be attached to every registration to allow him/her to sit for the examinations.

#### 2. PROCEDURE TO APPLY TO OFFER MORE THAN 7 SUBJECTS

- 2.1 To offer more than 7 subjects for the NSC, the subject must be offered in all three years of the phase.
  - The approval received in the Grade 10 year from the Department (office of the Head of Assessment body) must be attached to the entry forms of candidates who wish to offer more than 7 subjects in grade 12.
- 2.2 Application to offer more than 7 subjects must be made before the end of January in the year that the learner is in **Grade 10**.
- 2.3 Form must be completed.
- 2.4 These forms must be submitted to the Director: Examinations as hard copies.
- 2.5 A letter of approval will be sent to the school and the learner via the district.
- 2.6 A copy of the letter of approval must be attached to the registration to write the Gr 12 examination.
- 2.7 The additional subject should not compromise the Notional Time of the candidate (i.e 27h30 hours per week/cycle)

#### **APPLICATION: IMMIGRANT STATUS**

The application form must be completed and submitted by the end of May in the Gr. 12 year for all candidates that qualify for immigrant status.

The following should be considered when a learner apply for Immigrant status according to policy directives:

#### (1) Immigrants

- (a) An immigrant learner is:
  - (i) a child or a dependent of a diplomatic representative of a foreign government accredited in South Africa; or
  - (ii) a person who:
    - (aa) first enrolled at and entered a South African school in Grade 7 or a more senior grade, or
    - (bb) having begun his or her schooling at a school in South Africa, has attended school outside South Africa for two or more consecutive years after Grade 6 or its equivalent, and has subsequently returned to South Africa.













- (b) Subject to subparagraph (d) an immigrant learner as contemplated in subparagraph (a) must offer the two required official languages as contemplated in paragraphs 12(1) of the Intermediate Phase and 19(1) of the Senior Phase and comply with the School-Based Assessment requirements of both official languages offered.
- (c) An immigrant learner in the Intermediate or Senior Phase must:
  - (i) Pass one of the required two official languages as contemplated in subparagraph (b) on at least First Additional Language level and obtain a rating of Moderate Achievement (Level 3) in that language; and
  - (ii) Subject to subparagraph (e) an immigrant learner must comply with the Intermediate and Senior Phase promotion requirements as contemplated in paragraphs 14 and 21 respectively.
- (d) An immigrant learner may offer his or her home language in lieu of one official language, provided that it is an officially approved non-official language, provided further he or she complies with the Intermediate and Senior Phase promotion requirements as contemplated in *paragraphs 14* and *21* respectively.
  - (aa) If such language is listed on Home Language level in Table B4 at Annexure A
  - (bb) In the absence of the home language of the immigrant in Table B4 at Annexure A, such candidate may offer his or her home language on the A level of the General Certificate of Education (GCE) of the United Kingdom, or an examination recognised by the department of Education as equivalent to Home Language level for this purpose.
- (e) To be classified as an immigrant learner, such a learner must be in possession of:
  - The relevant official documentation issued by the Department of Home Affairs;
     and
  - (ii) The relevant official documentation issued by the school where the learner entered the South African school system for the first time.

**EXTRACT FROM Government Gazette 39435, 20 November 2015:** 

#### Amendment of Regulation 17 of the Regulations

- 5. Regulation 17 is hereby amended by
  - (a) the substitution for sub-regulation (1) of the following sub-regulation-
    - "(1) Subject changes must be done in Grade 10, provided this is done by the [beginning of the third term] end of the second term, subject to the approval of the Principal of the school where the learner is registered. Such must be done before 30 June of the 10 year"."
  - (b) the substitution for sub-paragraph (2) of the following sub-paragraph-
    - "(2) A learner may change two subjects in Grade 11, provided this is done before [28 February] 31 March, subject to the approval of the Principal of the school where the learner is registered".
  - (c) the substitution for sub-paragraph (3) of the following sub-paragraph
    - "(3) In exceptional cases a learner may change one additional subject in Grade [12] 11, provided this is done before 15 December of the Grade] 11-year"."
- Approval for changing a subject in grade 12 must be obtained from the Head of the Assessment body, or his or her representative, provided the following are furnished.
  - a. A letter of motivation from the learner's parent or quardian;
  - b. A letter from the Principal, either supporting or providing reasons for not supporting the change; and
  - c. A letter from the subject teacher, outlining the programme to be followed to assist the learner in covering those aspects of the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statements for the previuos grade that were not covered.
