## DEPARTMENTAL CIRCULAR 39 OF 2022 - PROHIBITION OF WITHHOLDING SCHOOL REPORT CARDS

- 1. The above subject refers.
- 2. The Offices of the Member of Executive Council and Superintendent-General are individually, inundated with complaints regarding schools which still withhold report cards from learners and/or parents until the latter have settled outstanding fees, debt or returned missing textbooks, tablet or any other item belonging to a school.
- 3. The above practice is outlawed.
- 4. In terms of Section 25 (12 and 13, respectively) of the *National Protocol on Assessment 2011*, a learner's "Parents or guardians have the right of access to report cards of their children", and "Schools may not withhold report cards from learners for any reason whatsoever".
- 5. The above regulation applies to both public and independent schools from Grades R-12.
- 6. It does not, however, prevent a school from using other means, such as legal action, to, for instance, obtain fees that may be overdue in terms of the contract between the school and a parent.
- 7. Disciplinary action may be taken against any school principal, school or their delegate found to be withholding a school report card or matric statement of results and/or certificate from a learner and/or their parents/guardians for any reason whatsoever.
