ADVERTISEMENT FOR EXAMINERS/CHIEF MARKERS, INTERNAL MODERATORS AND TRANSLATORS FOR NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC) EXAMINATIONS: GRADE 12 MARKING – JUNE 2024 TO DECEMBER 2026 AND SETTING OF NORTH WEST PREPARATORY PAPERS FOR SEPTEMBER 2025 TO SEPTEMBER 2027

- 1. Applications are open for suitably qualified and experienced candidates for the posts of
 - a) North West Provincial Chief Examiners/Markers and Internal Moderators and Translators for Grade 12 Preparatory Papers for the period of 2025 to 2027. Marking and moderation duties need to be performed by Chief Examiners/Markers, Translators and Internal Moderators during the NSC Gr. 12 marking from June 2024 to February 2027. (Annexure B).
 - b) North West Provincial Chief Marker or Internal Moderators that will perform marking and moderation duties during the NSC Grade 12 marking from June 2024 to February 2027 (Annexure C).

2. Requirements:

- 2.1 At least a recognised three year post matric qualification which must include the subject concerned at second- or third-year level.
- 2.2 Have extensive experience as an educator in the particular subject:
 - 2.2.1 At least 5 years teaching experience in the subject for Grade 12 or
 - 2.2.2 At least 3 years' experience as a Subject Specialist in the relevant subject
 - 2.2.3 Evidence of competency in the relevant computer software, e.g. (Word, Excel and Power Point)

- 2.3 Experience in one of the following is compulsory:
 - (a) Grade 12 Marker (For at least 3 years),
 - (b) Senior Marker,
 - (c) Deputy Chief Marker
 - (d) Subject Analysts
 - (e) Chief Marker.
 - (f) Internal Moderator
- 2.4 Principals or acting Principals of schools or learning institutions may not apply.
- 2.5 SGB appointees may not apply.
- 2.6 The applicant must be teaching the applicable subject in 2024 in a Grade 12 class.
- 2.7 An official who applies for the post of Translator MUST teach the applicable subject in Afrikaans. (An official who teaches in both languages may apply to be a translator).

3. Responsibilities:

3.1 Examiners and Internal moderators will be responsible for setting, moderating and quality assuring the Grade 12 question papers for August/September 2025, August/September 2026 and August/September 2027, according to the National requirements.

(For the first 39 papers only – Annexure B)

- 3.2 Chief Markers and Internal moderators will be expected to manage marking for the periods stated below:
 - 3.2.1 December 2024
 - 3.2.2 February, June & December 2025
 - 3.2.3 February, June & December 2026
 - 3.2.4 February 2027
- 3.3 Examiners and Internal moderators will have to stick to the time schedule to set, moderate and translate the Preparatory Papers according to the management plan that will be provided.
