THE FINAL 2024 MAY/ JUNE EXAMINATION TIMETABLE – NATIONAL SENIOR CERTFICATE (NSC) AND SENIOR CERTFICATE (SC).

- At the Council of Education Ministers (CEM) meeting held on Thursday, 7 March 2024, the 2024 May/June Examination Timetable was discussed and approved (Annexure A).
- The examination commences on Monday 29 April 2024 and will conclude on Thursday 13 June 2024. The re-write opportunity for Computer Application Technology (CAT) and Information Technology (IT) will also take place at 9:00 on Thursday, 13 June 2024.
- 3. With the announcement by the President of the General Elections being scheduled for 29 May 2024, no examinations will take place on the day preceding the election and the day, post the elections to allow candidates that need to travel to their hometowns to cast the vote and to accommodate schools that will be used as voting stations.
- 4. The May/ June Examination results will be released on Wednesday, 7 August 2024.
