- Incorrect spelling will not be penalized in Comprehension unless the spelling changes the meaning of the word or makes the word incomplete.
- Spelling and language errors should be penalized in ALL Language questions.
- For open-ended questions, no mark should be awarded for YES/NO or TRUE/FALSE if no reason/substantiation/motivation is given.
- Where one-word answers are required and learners give a whole sentence, mark correct provided that the correct word is underline /highlighted.
- For multiple choice questions, accept EITHER the letter corresponding with the correct answer OR the answer written out in full.
- Do not award $\frac{1}{2}$ marks.
